Life Skills....

We all need to learn the basics and this starts at home. The staff at Sithney encourage independence from the day the children start in reception. Our children take responsibility for their learning and behaviour. We support them where they find things tricky; maybe it is tying shoe laces, doing up zips or buttons to feeling apprehensive about coming into school.

There is one area which all the staff have noticed that many of our children struggle, even some of the older ones and this is at lunch time! We are focusing on using cutlery correctly, pouring drinks, table manners and tidying away their plates. Please can we ask that you support

us in this with showing or encouraging independence ie: laying the table, cutting up their own food, using cutlery correctly, pouring a drink from a jug, clearing the table after tea etc. If your child has a packed lunch, check to see if they can open their lunch box, can they open the food you provide (there is some very tricky packaging out there!).
