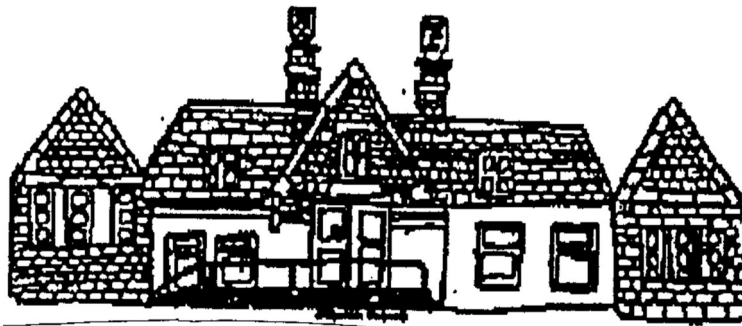

We must insist though that NO parents

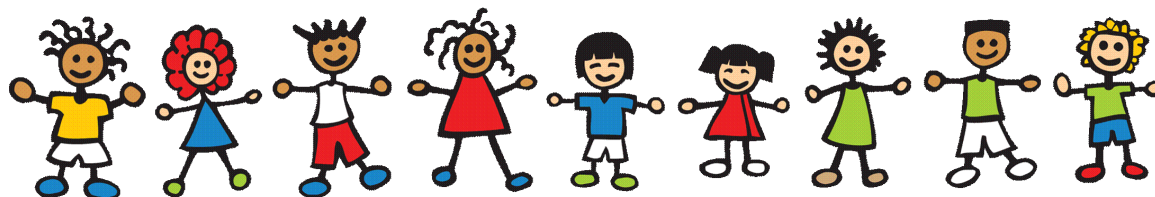
(apart from those who have an agreement with school) should park in the layby on the yellow hashed area.
