Pupil Premium Opportunities...

Some of you may be aware all schools receive additional funding called 'Pupil Premium' (there is a detailed break down on our web site as to how this money is used).

This premium is allocated to groups of children who have been highlighted that may require additional support due to social/economical need, as defined by the DFE.

We all know that children in KS1 receive the universal free school meals but this doesn't stop parents of KS1 or KS2 registering for pupil premium, if their circumstances allow.

The Pupil Premium budget opens up opportunities to our children, by allowing us to offer experiences which would other wise be unaffordable to school/parents.



Our most recent opportunity which we shall be offering our children is a residential trip to Coverack YHA, this coming Tuesday and Wednesday, for our Y6 children.

They will have the chance to organise their learning experience and practice life skills—from writing their menu to purchasing food, cooking and

cleaning up along with numerous educational opportunities. For some it may be the first time spent away from home, but for all it will be chance to see that learning is life long and for them to put into practice what they have learnt through their life so far.
