## What's going on at Sithney

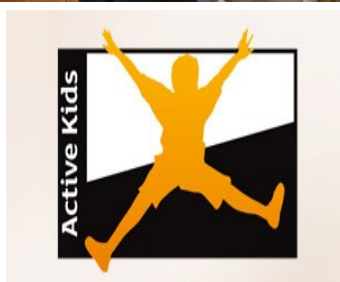
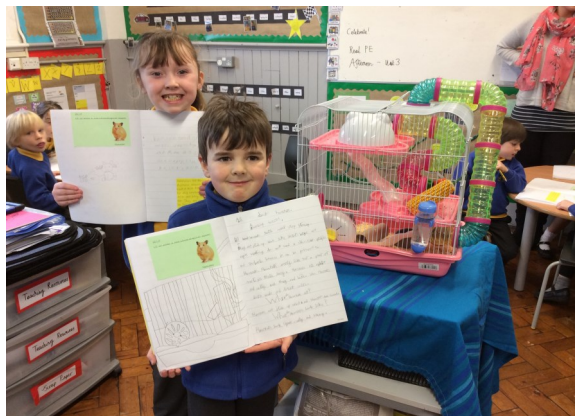
